

A healthy distraction, legally speaking.

Quick-start rules for every supplied city box. Start with five white cards, rotate the judge clockwise, and collect 2,000 imaginary billable hours to win.

- 1 Separate and deal**
Make face-down blue and white piles. Every player takes five white answer cards.
- 2 Appoint the judge**
Nominate the first judge, or appoint whoever billed the most hours that week.
- 3 Read blue, play white**
The judge reveals and reads the top blue card, saying 'blank' for each blank. Every non-judge plays one white card.
- 4 Read and plead**
The judge reads every completed combination aloud. Non-judges may classlessly plead their cases.
- 5 Award 400 hours**
The judge chooses a winner. Only that player takes back their winning white card and leaves it face up. Other played white cards stay out of play.
- 6 Rotate and win**
Move the judge role clockwise and repeat. The first player with five face-up white cards has 2,000 imaginary billable hours and wins.

Card custody

Do not refill physical hands: the supplied rules say only the winning white card returns, face up, as the 400-hour record. The losing white cards stay out of play.

Digital companion

The shared box QR opens these rules first, plus a local-only timer and scorekeeper and links to the Calgary, Vancouver, and Toronto digital decks. Ordinary players join as guests. No email or marketing consent is required to play.
